#### Checklist to start your CNA Career:

#### CTE Intake:

- 1. Bring a photo ID and fill out the Interest Application form to begin your registration.
- Students will be provided with the CASAS Testing Schedule for anyone without a high school diploma/equivalency or a diploma no more than 5 years old.
- CASAS score must be at 8<sup>th</sup> grade level to qualify.
   Only three attempts per school year.
   Intervention available by enrolling in AZTEC lab.
- Email Interview Invitations will be sent to qualified candidates
- 5. Selected CNA candidates will receive an Admission Invitation to attend the CNA Orientation

#### **Pre-requisite Class:**

 Computer in the Workplace (CIW) — Class must be completed before start of the CNA cohort or pass the challenge test

**Note:** A high school diploma or equivalent (i.e. GED, HiSet) within 5 years or 8<sup>th</sup> grade reading level. HS diploma required for hire.
